GENERAL INFORMATION

A liquor licence does not override local laws, planning schemes and conditions on planning permits. It is the licensee's responsibility to ensure they comply with these.

TYPE OF LICENCE

This licence is a late night (general) licence and authorises the licensee to supply liquor on the licensed premises for consumption on and off the licensed premises during the trading hours specified below.

AMFNITY

The licensee must not cause or permit undue detriment (caused by noise or any other factor) to the amenity of the area to arise out of or in connection with the use of the premises to which the licence relates during or immediately after the trading hours authorised under this licence.

DELIVERY OF LIQUOR

Liquor must not be delivered after 11pm on any day, or at any time on Good Friday or Christmas Day, or before 12 noon on ANZAC Day.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

These special conditions prevail over any conditions above to the extent of any inconsistency.

When live or recorded amplified music other than background music is provided after 8 p.m. on any day:

- The licensee shall install and maintain a surveillance recording system able to clearly identify individuals, which shows time and date and provides continuous images of all entrances and exits, bars and entertainment/dance floor areas. The surveillance recording system must operate from 30 minutes before the start of the entertainment being provided, until 30 minutes after closure. A copy of the recorded images must be available upon request for immediate viewing or removal by the Victoria Police, or a person authorised in writing by the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation, or otherwise retained for at least one month. The position of the cameras will be to the satisfaction of the Licensing Inspector.
- Crowd controllers, licensed under the Private Security Act 2004, are to be employed at a ratio of 2 crowd controllers for the first 100 patrons and 1 crowd controller for each additional 100 patrons or part thereof. One crowd controller is to be present outside the premises to monitor patrons arriving at and departing from the premises. Crowd controllers are to be present from 30 minutes before the start of the entertainment being provided, until 30 minutes after closure.

ADDITIONAL BEER GARDEN CONDITIONS

- On Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights between 8 p.m. and 11 p.m., amplified music greater than background music and live entertainment in the form of bands may be provided in the Beer Garden.
- On any day between 2 p.m. and 8 p.m., live entertainment in the form of a solo artist, singing duo or trio may be provided in the Beer Garden or inside the main building of the hotel. When this entertainment is being provided there is no requirement to have licensed crowd controllers at the premises.
- All sales from the bar located in the Beer Garden are to cease at Midnight.
- All sales for consumption in the Beer Garden are to cease by 12.30 a.m.
- All consumption of liquor is to cease in the Beer Garden by 1 a.m. No patrons to be present in the Beer Garden after 1a.m. other than for the purpose of smoking.

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE (Continued)

• At least one crowd controller is to be present from 12 midnight onwards on any occasion that there are patrons in the Beer Garden.

SPECIAL OCCASION TRADING HOURS

On the following Special Occasion Weekends trading hours for external areas are to be the same as is permitted for
consumption internally on the licensed premises: New Years Eve, Australia Day Weekend (Friday, Saturday and Sunday),
Southern Eighty Ski Weekend (Friday & Saturday), Labour Day Weekend (Friday, Saturday and Sunday), Easter (Friday,
Saturday and Sunday), Christmas Eve, Boxing Day and the first three weekends (Friday and Saturday) post Christmas.
